- 1. Enhance the welcome document that is given out to the new IG Reps.
- 2. Explore hybrid event options &/or concurrent virtual options during the in-person events.
- 3. Let Committee Chairs get in touch with other Committee Chairs in other Inter Groups.
- 4. Expand our communication around the service structure that exists within OA, which would include promoting Region 6 and World Service events on our Greater NY Metro IG calendar.
- 5. A timed discussion during our IG meeting in order to allow IG Reps to discuss what is happening at their individual meetings and voice any issues or concerns (including meetings that have lost their treasury, meeting contact(s), Zoom info, etc.). This way ideas could be exchanged and shared.
- 6. Explore the possibility of Greater NY Metro IG providing a dedicated Zoom account that all groups would be able to use for new or existing virtual meetings.
- 7. Good & Welfare being included on future Greater NY IG agendas to give an opportunity for voting reps to raise any issues of concern for their individual meetings &/or our IG Committees.
- 8. Creating locally produced literature & reviewing the process to implement this.
- 9. Training & ongoing support for operating Zoom during meetings as well as making use of Zoom's &/or Linked In Learning's Educational resources.
- 10. Piggy- backing on Region 6's social media accounts &/or creating social media accounts for Greater NY Metro IG via our Outreach committee & with the guidance of Region 6 Contact: Jenn about this!!!
- 11. Hands on learning & service available at Region 6 via the link.
- 12. Officers, Committee Chairs, Committee Members & IG Reps to attend individual meetings to say, "Hi!" and share what we're up to at Greater NY Metro. Invite people to join us.
- 13. In the Highlights Reel, create a blurb on what we do at IG.
- How do we keep the learning going? What abt Secession? Are there documents that we can share to help inspire you and inspire your committee? Can the yearly handover be improved?
- What abt the Google Ad Campaign? Someone is needed to oversee that. It would need to be someone who is interested in Social Media. Jenn???
- What is the most efficient next Step? Re: Treasurer. On our way to having a Treasurer or, at least a Bookkeeper. We'll keep you posted.
- What could you hear at IG that you're not hearing? Is there something that IG could be doing that wd be more useful? And how can we become more effective?
